


Detail of the 1926 plan – showing elements of the baroque garden, as well as the ground plan of the medieval abbey

Plan of the medieval buildings an interpretation following the "Idealplan", that is the usual layout of Cistercian monasteries









Garden ruins - The Eastern range before excavation
















Fragments of a marble plate /radius ~ 1m/ and a possible reconstruction of the fountain
















SE corner of Eastern range






Chapter house from W, in situ base of pillar






Baroque wall, from W





Test trenches (1,2,5,6) W from baroque wall













Decayed floor - S range (inside of the refectory(?))














Animal head - piece of a bronze tap/bowl










