

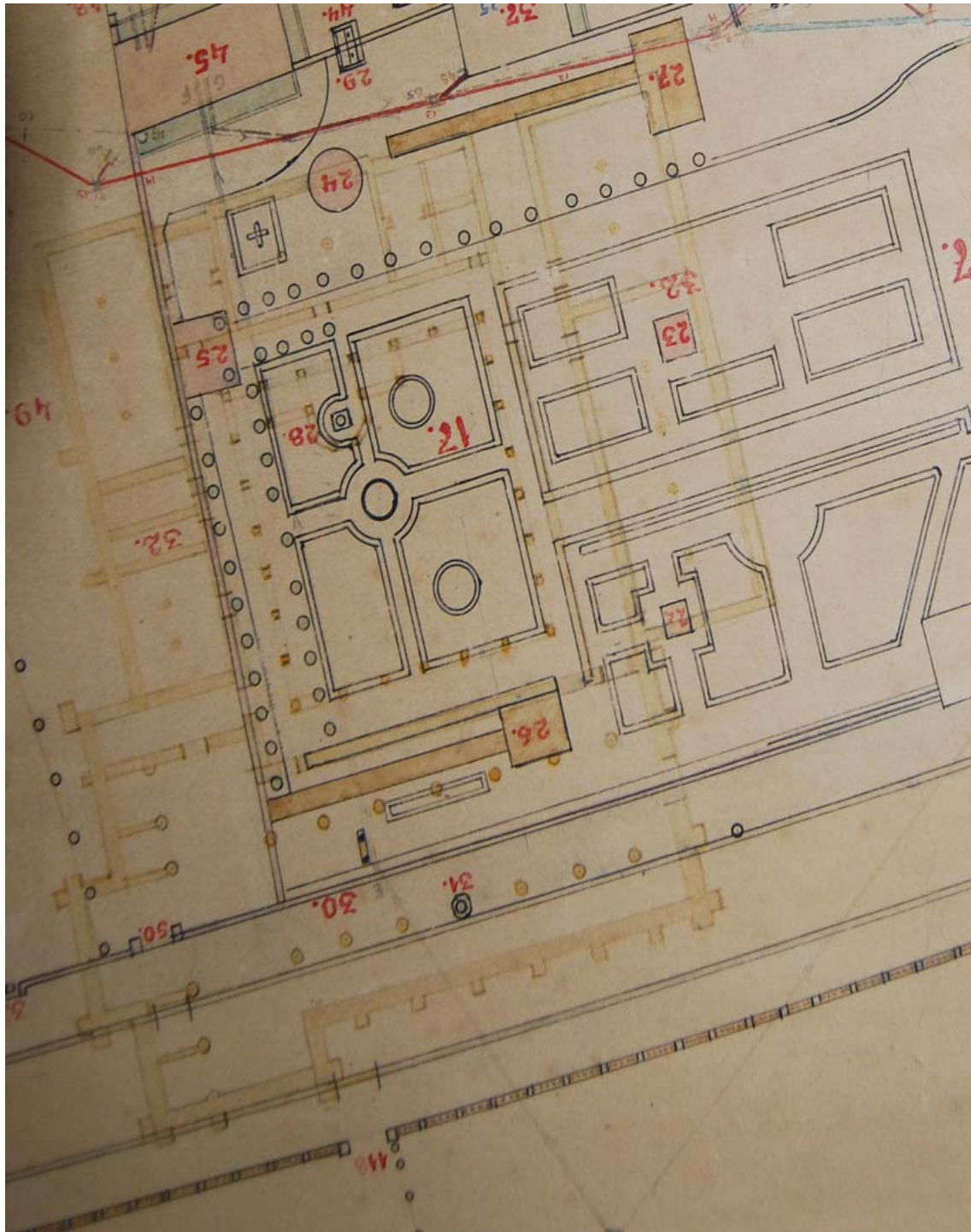

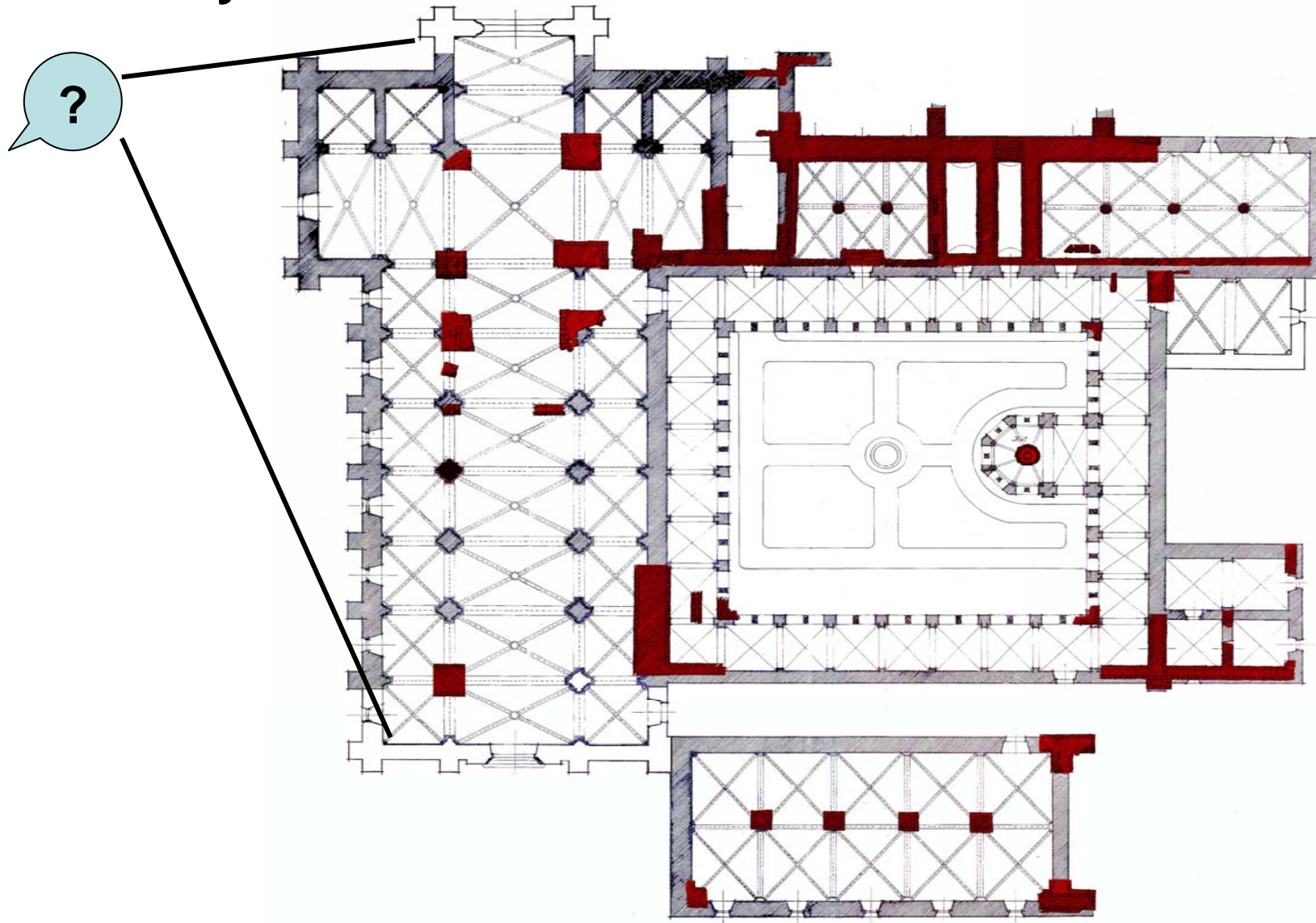






**Detail of the 1926 plan

usual layout of Cistercian monasteries**

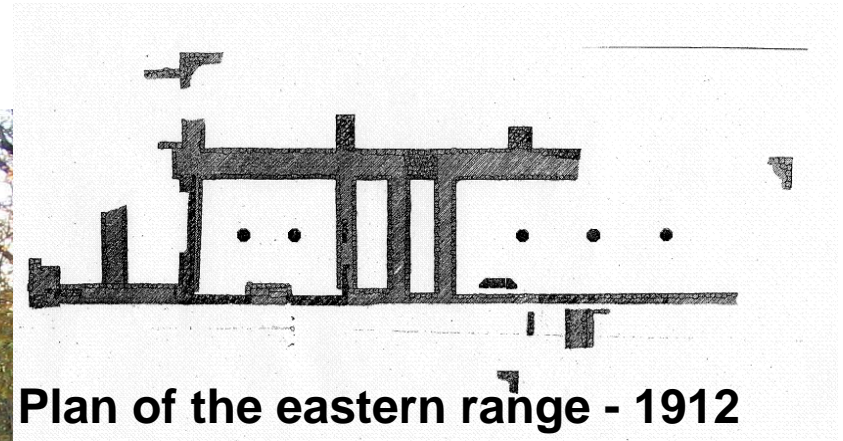


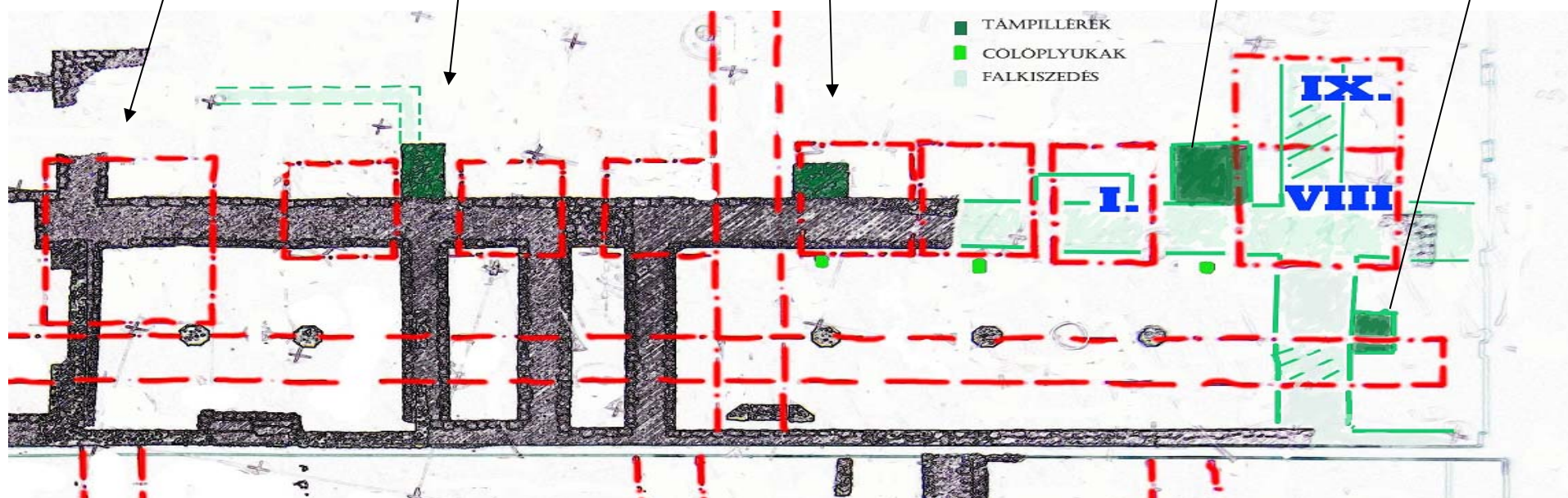
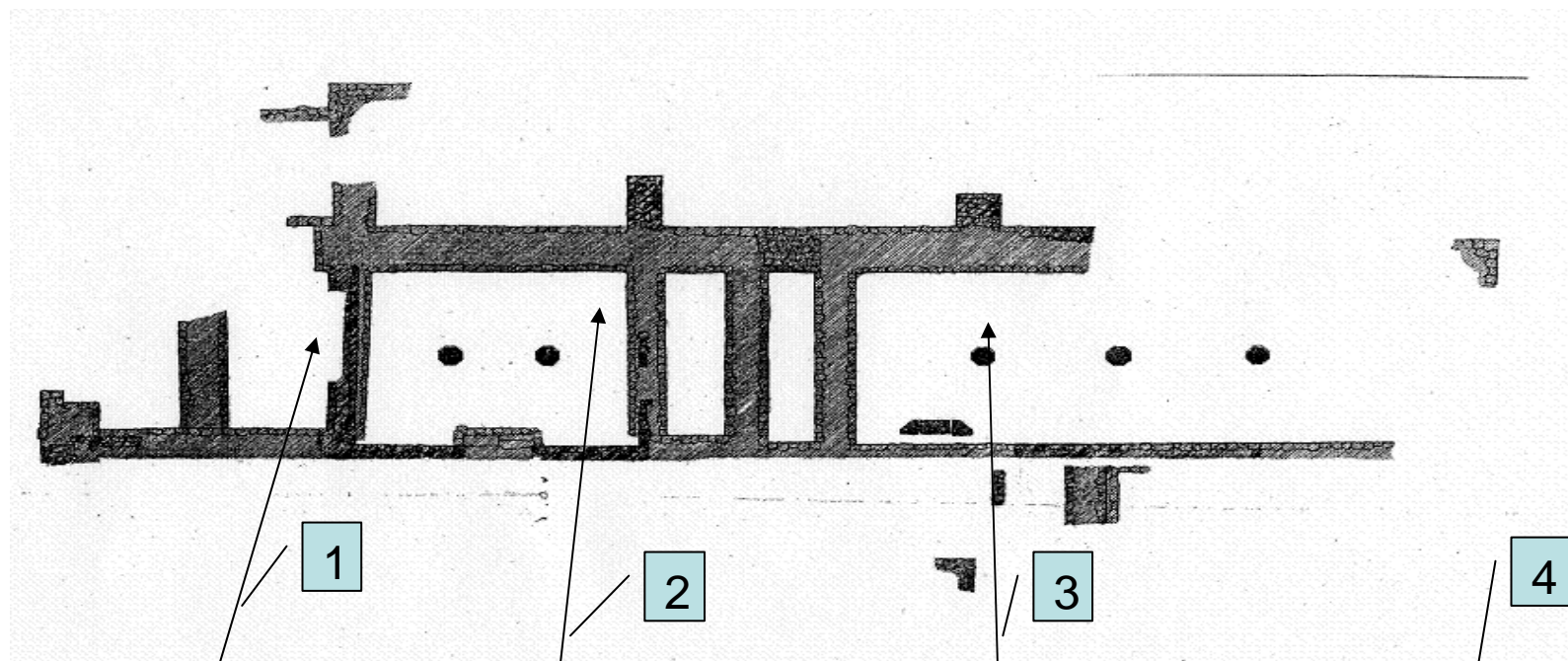

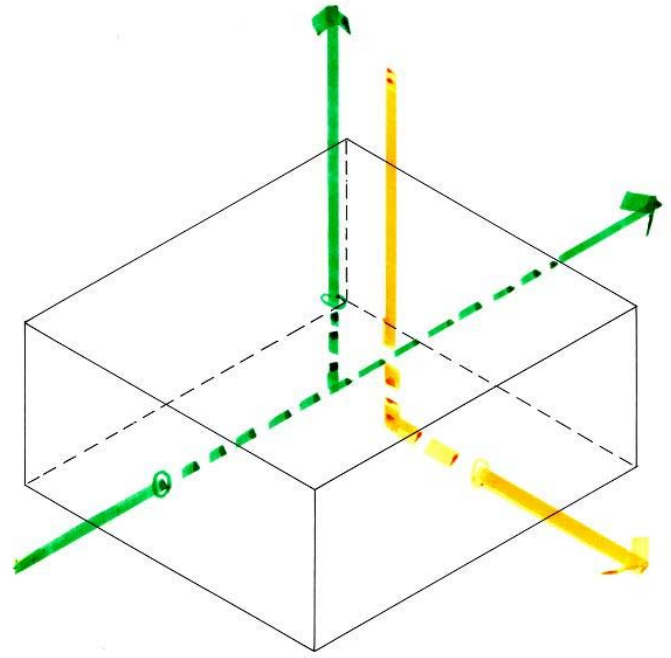


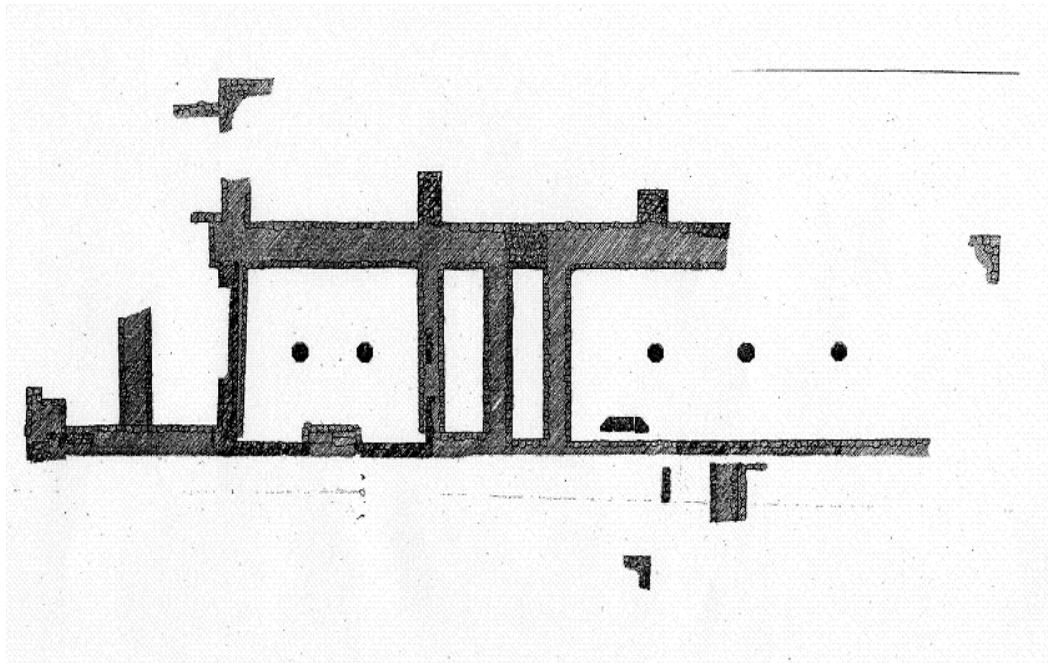




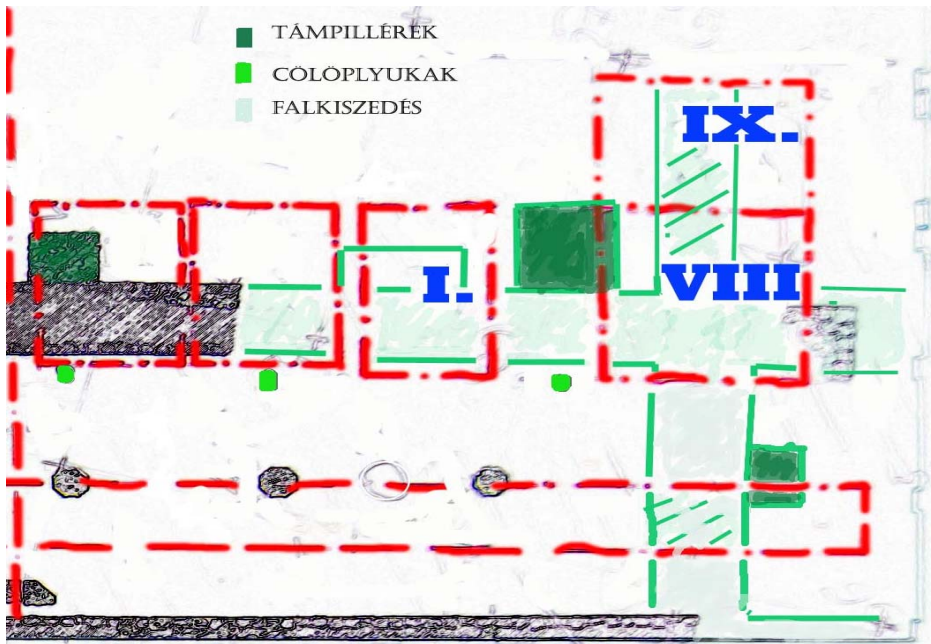
Fragments of a marble plate /radius ~ 1m/ and a possible reconstruction of the fountain

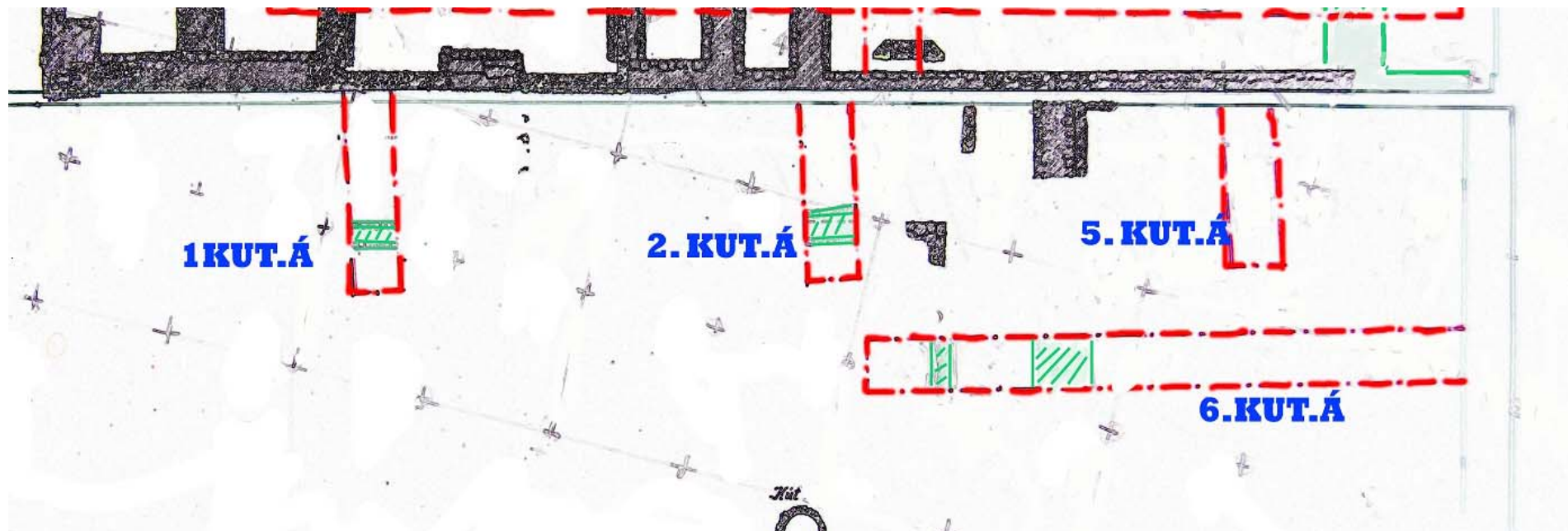

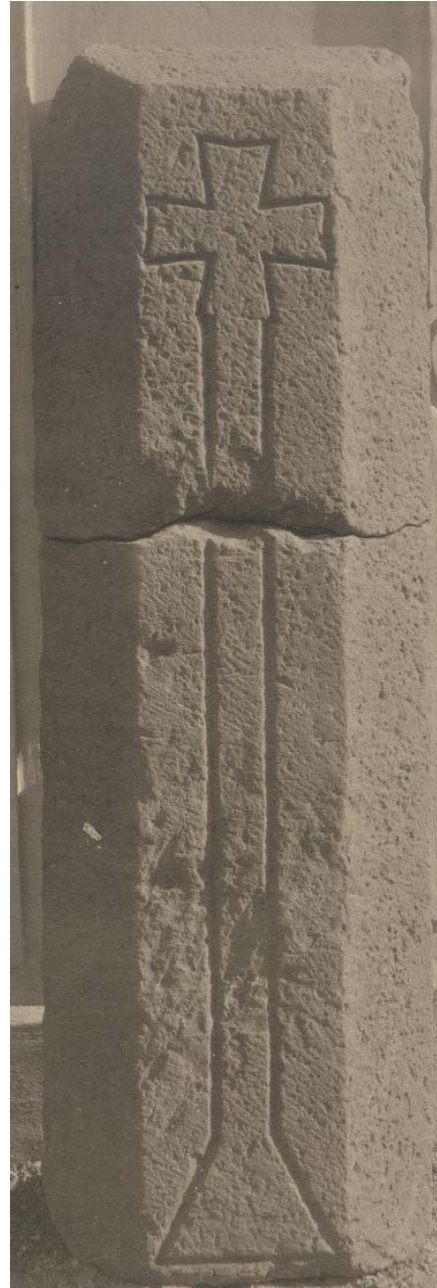

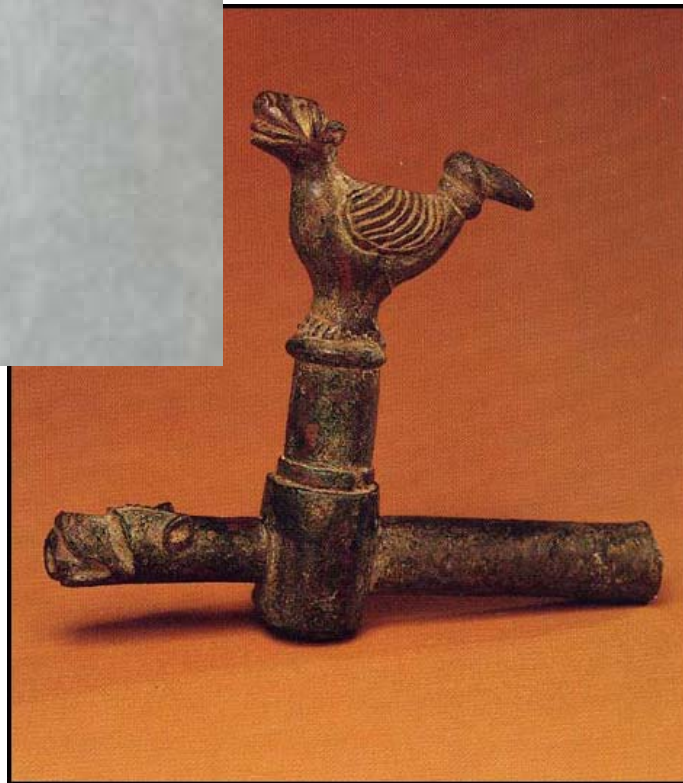
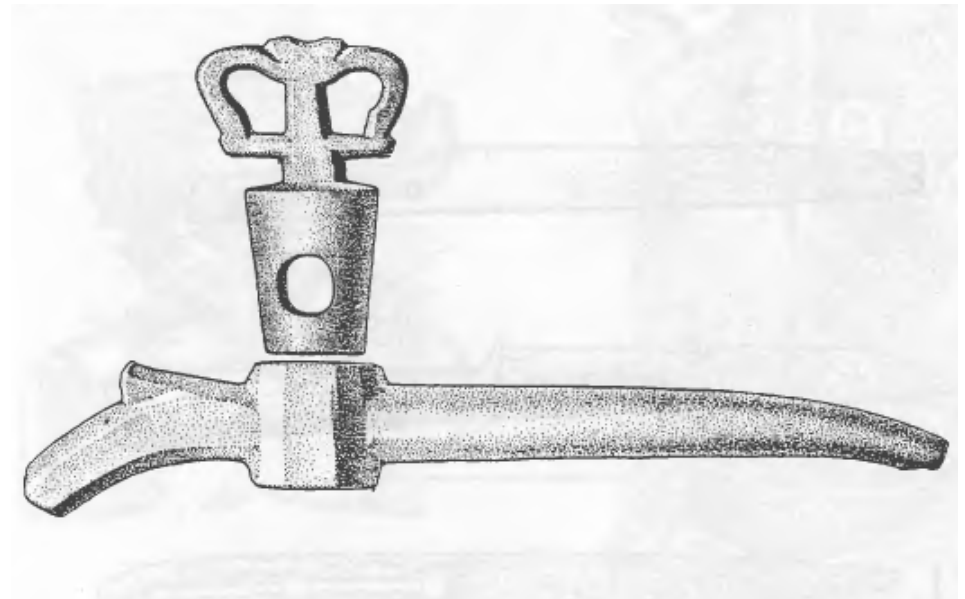

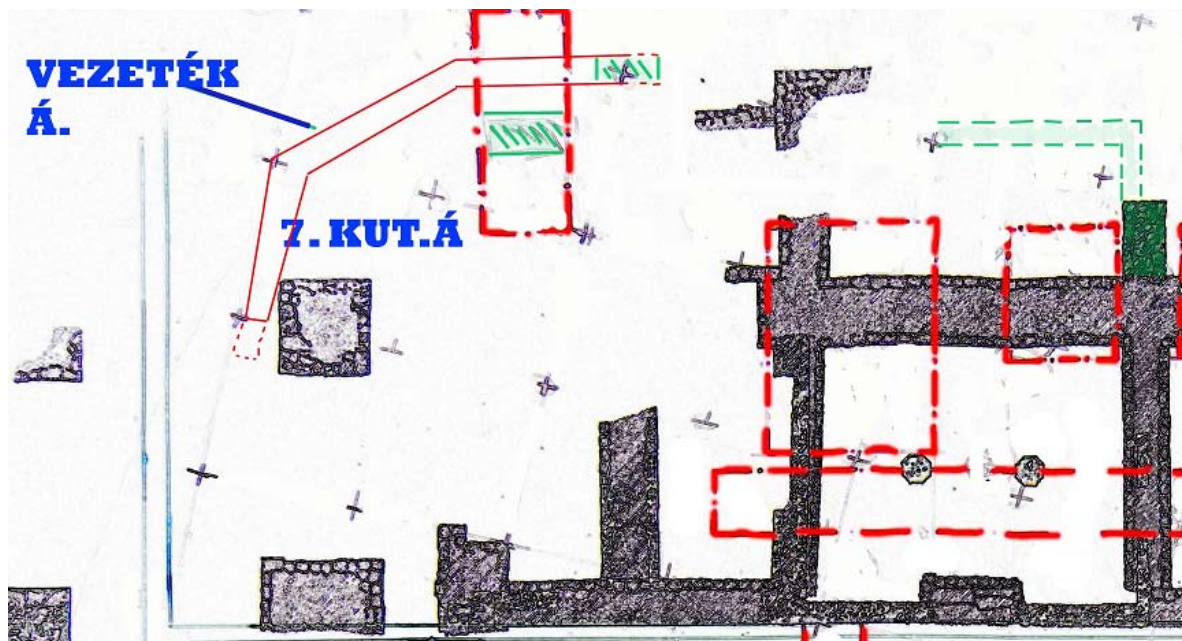
